Lady Macbeth faints in order to distract Malcolm and Donalbain, who run away thinking they are going to be next. Malcolm goes to England. This gives Macbeth justification to suggest that they are responsible for their father's death and that he should take the throne and lead the country in Malcolm's absence.

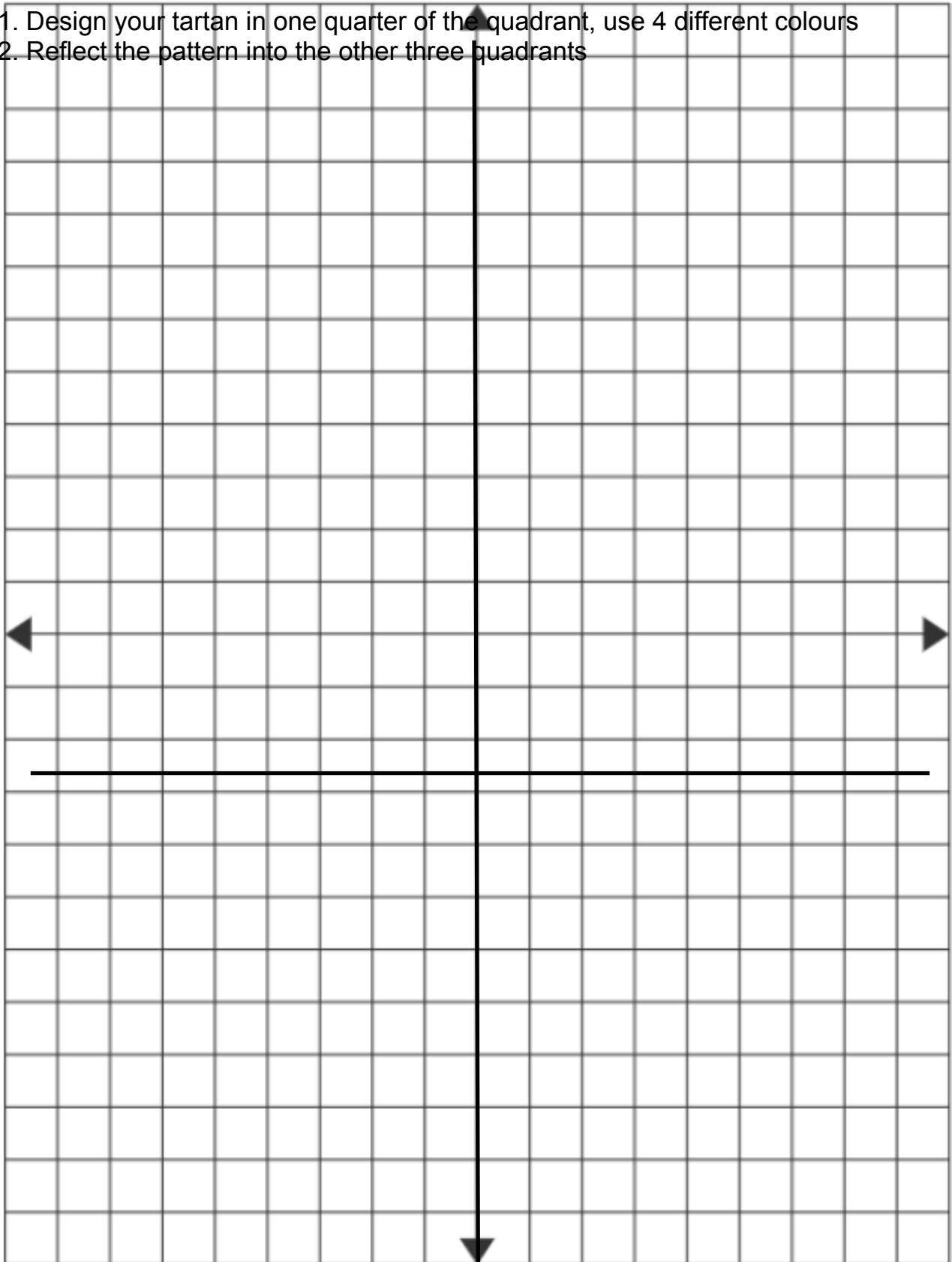
MATHS

TARTAN IS A WOVEN WOOLLEN CLOTH. IT COMES IN MANY DIFFERENT PATTERNS OF COLOURED CHECKS AND INTERSECTING LINES. TARTAN DESIGNS ARE ESPECIALLY ASSOCIATED WITH A PARTICULAR SCOTTISH CLAN.

DESIGN MACBETH'S TARTAN 1

1. Design your tartan in one quarter of the quadrant, use 4 different colours
2. Reflect the pattern into the other three quadrants



DESIGN MACBETH'S TARTAN 2

1. Design your tartan in one quarter of the quadrant, use 4 different colours
2. Each colour must represent exactly $\frac{1}{4}$ of the pattern
3. Reflect the pattern into the other three quadrants
